The Time of the Ancient Mariner narrates the tale of an old mariner who ventures to the polar seas and kills an albatross which was believed by the crew to be leading the ship to safety.

The Influence of Samuel Taylor Coleridge and His Work on:--

His most famous works – "The Rime of the Ancient Mariner", 'Kubla Khan' and 'Christabel' – all featured supernatural themes and exotic images, perhaps affected by his use of the drugs. Coleridge was as much a prose and theoretical writer as he was a poet, as revealed in his major work, Biographia Literaria, published in 1817. Coleridge's legacy has been tainted with accusations of plagiarism, both in his poetry and critical essays.

Samuel Taylor Coleridge — author of 'The Rime of the:--

Coleridge describes the ghost ship as having "ribs," an image that parallels the mariner who is old but unable to die. "The naked hulk alongside came and the twain were casting dice" (3.195-196). Death and Life-in-Death are gamble for the souls of the crew, which also a very traditional myth, similar to the myth of Davy Jones.

Supernaturalism in Coleridge's "The Rime of the Ancient:--

The eponymous protagonist - though without identity, is merely referred to as "The Ancient Mariner", where the adjective "Ancient" perhaps refers to wisdom gained from time, however his outstanding features imply otherwise: the "bright eyed mariner", whose "glittering eye" is described frequently in the narrative, emphasizing possible insanity - which is supported when even the wedding guest refers to him simply as a "grey-beard loon".

The Rime of the Ancient Mariner Essay | Imagination in:--

Like the Ancient Mariner of Coleridge's poem, the nameless workman compels her to listen and accord him the authority that great suffering demands. He wrests the reader's attention away from the main figure of the anecdote, the benevolent "Mrs. Gaskell," and renders her speechless — at least for a while.
