All learning, verbal and non-verbal, takes place through habits. Positive reinforcement and repetition help with forming the habit. First, imitation of the language occurs, followed by the learner repeating what is heard. The learner is then reinforced positively for their actions and the habit is formed.

Theories - Teaching English Language Learners

A rapid means of learning foreign languages (use to train military troops). It is a pattern of drills and dialogue designed to develop grammatical structures and vocabulary in a highly sequential manner. Teachers reinforced accurate production and error correction through consistent feedback.
