In the UK, human rights are protected by the Human Rights Act 1998. The Act gives effect to the human rights set out in the European Convention on Human Rights. Article 8 - the right to respect for your family and private life, your home and your correspondence is one the rights protected by the Human Rights Act.

Your right to respect for private and family life ...

The Human Rights Act; Article 2: Right to life; Article 3: Freedom from torture and inhuman or degrading treatment; Article 4: Freedom from slavery and forced labour; Article 5: Right to liberty and security; Article 6: Right to a fair trial; Article 7: No punishment without law; Article 8: Respect for your private and family life

Human rights are the basic rights and freedoms that belong to every person in the world. The European Convention on Human Rights protects the human rights of people in countries that belong to the Council of Europe. This includes the UK. If you think your human rights under the European Convention have been breached, you may be able to take a case to court in the UK.

Human rights - Citizens Advice

In the UK, human rights are protected by the Human Rights Act 1998. Only public authorities must follow the Human Rights Act. This means you can take action under the Human Rights Act if a public authority has breached your human rights. But you can ' t take action against a private individual as they ' re not covered by the Act.
