Humanitarian intervention and the R2P both agree on the fact that sovereignty is not absolute. However, the R2P doctrine shifts away from state-centered motivations to the interests of victims by focusing not on the right of states to intervene but on a responsibility to protect populations at risk.

As a principle, R2P aims to reconcile the two sides. It stresses that state sovereignty includes both rights and responsibilities: a right to govern over a territory, but a responsibility to the population living in that territory. The term Responsibility to Protect comes from a report written in response to Kofi Annan's call.
